Please note at the end of the above events all athletes, officials and spectators should make their way around the outside of the track to await the Queen's Baton Relay.

Notes:

- The meeting is open to male and female athletes in age groups under 11 to senior. Under 11s must be 9 on the day of the event.
- The event is a non UKA event. Times/distances will be unofficial.
- Athletes can enter three events and the 4x100m relay.
- Athletes must complete an entry slip (see back page) for each event entered.
- Registration will be open from 12.30-2.30pm, **but you must register at least 30mins before the event.**
- Pre-entries are required for the relays. Entries must be submitted to the Ayrshire Athletics Arena, Queens Drive, Kilmarnock, KA1 3XF, by Tuesday 17 June at 8pm.
- Officials will try to accommodate, as best as possible, competitors who are competing in multi-events.
- Age groups may be combined in the case of low entries.
- **There will be no parking at the Athletics Arena and athletes/visitors will be expected to park at the Scott Ellis overspill car park.**
