Treasurer Summary 2015/16

The Club reports a surplus of £2,743 in the year and the club remains in a sound financial position

Membership is little changed at 435(433) with 153(136) Seniors and 282(297) Juniors, with a waiting list for entry to the Junior section featuring through much of the year to manage demand. We operate 4 nights a week which puts a great call on the time and commitment of the coaches and volunteer team who support the Club throughout the year.

In response to the growth in membership we have continued to invest in coach development. We have also commenced a program to improve the administration of club membership and attendance records which has involved the purchase of PCs. We expect to get benefit from this in the years ahead. In addition we will move to an online membership record keeping and subscription collection in 2016 which is expected to improve not only our information, but also membership fee collection.

Although we spent relatively little on sports equipment in the year we expect this to change in 2016.

2016 will also see the reintroduction of a 10k race in Kilmarnock - Roon the Toon, in which Kilmarnock Harriers have been key in organising and promoting. Thanks to the efforts of all involved in securing sponsorship and a high level of pre entries, this event is expected to be self-funding.

East Ayrshire Leisure and in particular the team at AAA provide us not only with great facilities but also great support and encouragement in all of our activities. The hire rates are very well priced and as far as possible we look to agree a pricing structure which maximises flexibility and participation for the Club whilst meeting the financial and community use objectives of the AAA.
