### **Changing**

# Warming-up / Course Access

Please keep clear of the football pitches. To gain access to the Start / Finish and Team Tent area, you are required to cross the course. Please stay within markers and watch out for runners.

### Course

The course consists of a mixture of parkland, riverside path and farmers fields (normally used for livestock). On the big lap there is also a section of rough road under the A77. Most competitors have reported that this is OK for spikes.

- From the Ayrshire Athletics Arena, continue on Queen's Drive/A735 for 0.1 miles (yellow dotted line)
  and at first roundabout take the second exit. Continue for 0.2 miles and at roundabout take the second
  exit.
- Move into outside lane and turn right at the traffic lights onto Newmill Road.
- Continue for 0.3 miles and competitor car park is on the right.
